## **Tips for creating a home inventory**

- Get started now
- Don't stress about documenting everything at once—any information helps
- Tackle one room at a time
- List items found in each room, and don't forget to check your drawers and closets
- Include the model, serial number, and brand of each item if possible
- Check your garage, patio, and deck
- Remember to update your inventory when you purchase new items and review the list at least annually
